





Columbine (*Aquilegia* spp.)

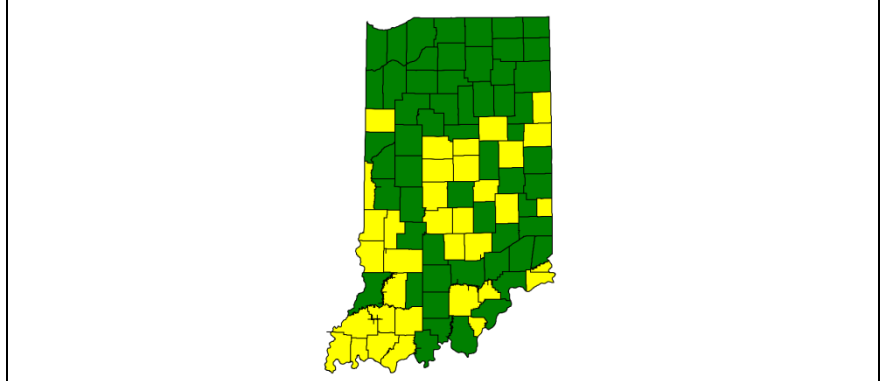
Notes:

The European Columbine can come in many colors, but only rarely escapes the gardens to be a persistent wild plant. The native Red Columbine is typically found in woodlands.

<p>Found mostly in or near gardens.</p>	<p>Found in higher quality woodlands.</p>
	
<p>Flowers can be many different colors. The stamens protrude slightly past the petals.</p>	<p>Generally reddish. The stamens protrude well past the petals.</p>
